Dear Parents and Carers,

#### Resilience

Resilience is related to a child's personal capacity not only to manage stress but also to come out of a difficult situation positively. To come out 'on top'. To bounce back.

Resiliency is not being happy all the time, not about being brave and not about always being strong. Resilience has a genetic component some individuals are naturally more resilient than others (eg. glass half full vs glass half empty). Even though some are more naturally resilient than others, resilience is mostly a learned approach and influenced by experiences and relationships. Individuals who are not naturally resilient are the ones who need opportunities to practice being resilient the most.

Strategies to Build Resilience

- Secure relationships and predictable home life
- Regular bed times
- Regular routines
- Regular meal times shared together
- Consistent disciplining techniques
- Accepting some aspects of sibling rivalry, don't become the referee. Take 5, give prompts etc
- Don't solve problems..... "how could we..." Ask questions that avoid yes and no.
- Providing opportunities for children to take some risks, make some decisions eg. ride a bike, climb a tree, go on slippery slide.

Adults must model resilient thinking by sharing feelings, sharing optimism and reflective listening. Acknowledge emotions, allow children to feel how they feel, don't always save them.

Encourage exploration don't always solve everything for them, try using questions such as:

How might we solve this? What do you think? Is there another way?

Try not to save your children as you won't always to around to save or fix things for them. Build their resilience! (Early Life Foundations)

## 2016 Parramatta Diocesan Team Sport Trials

Any Primary students enrolled in Year 5 and 6 in 2016 are invited to participate in the Parramatta Diocesan Team Sport Trials during Term Four in 2015 and Term One in 2016.

It is important to note that these trials are generally for those children who display an above average ability and/or have representative experience in their chosen sport. While teams are open in age it is strongly recommended that only children of a representative standard in Years 5 & 6 in 2016 be invited to attend.

Parramatta Diocesan trials will be held in the following sports:

\*AFL (boys), Basketball (B&G), Cricket (B&G), Diving (B&G), Hockey (B&G), Football (B&G), Golf (B&G), Hockey (B&G), Netball (girls), Rugby League (11yrs & Opens), Rugby Union (boys), Softball (B&G), Tennis (B&G), & Touch (B&G).

To be eligible for selection for these trials an Online Team Registration Form must be completed that can be accessed via the website <u>www.primarysportparra.catholic.edu.au</u>. This online form is an **EXPRESSION OF INTEREST** for the 2016 Parramatta Diocesan Primary Sport Team trials. You may complete this form to attend a selection trial or if you have been selected in a representative squad or team. One form is to be completed per child, per individual sport. Each sport has its own criteria therefore, it is imperative that the correct form is completed.

Please note that your online registration is an **EXPRESSION OF INTEREST ONLY** and **MUST be approved by your child's school**. In order for your child to attend the nominated trial or event this may come down to the discretion of your school as to who is selected to attend the trial. In some sports only 2 students per school can be nominated. **Please complete all fields and especially "Representative Experience".** 

Your child's school will notify you one week prior to the trial date if your child is to attend to the Parramatta Diocesan trial for their selected sport by providing a trial information sheet.

Under no circumstances will a child be eligible to trial if the Online Registration Form has not been completed and approved by the school by the closing date.

Currently only the Summer Sports of BASKETBALL, CRICKET, SOFTBALL & TENNIS are open and registrations close on Friday 30<sup>th</sup> October as these trials will be held in November 2015. All other sport registrations will open on 2<sup>nd</sup> November for 2016 trials.
