Information regarding Independent Education Union and the Greens

Information regarding the ongoing campaign from the Independent Education Union and the Greens party to abolish the freedom that faith-based schools have to employ people who will act in accordance with the beliefs and teachings of their religion.

You may have heard about the inclusion of a Catholic ethos clause as a key issue within the current Enterprise Agreement for teachers. Current legislation allows Catholic and other faith-based schools to require that staff support the mission, teaching and values of our faith in schools.

To remove this ability seeks to remove the religious nature our Catholic schools - the very reason why our schools exist.

These arrangements allow us the freedom to run our schools in a way that expresses our faith and provides parents with the ability to have their children educated in an environment that is consistent with their family's beliefs and values.

The ongoing negotiations for an Enterprise Agreement for teachers have canvassed a range of issues, which employers will shortly be seeking to settle with the IEU.

The issue of Catholic ethos is one that is fundamental to the future of our schools.

Learning Matters

Dear Parents,

I know you are all looking forward to the upcoming holidays. It's great to have some time to take things more slowly and to build up our energy levels once more. I wish you a happy Easter as we celebrate the glory of Christ's Resurrection.

As you are well aware the teachers at Holy Spirit are focused on improving the Reading ability of all the children. So with this in mind our "Early Bird Reading Program" will begin in **Week 2** of next term.

In brief this involves readers and tutors meeting in the MPA at about 8:30am. The older children will listen to their younger buddies read. Cards will be stamped to keep a check on how many times the children attend the sessions during the term. Certificates will be issued to children who consistently attend. Teachers will be supervising the session. This is not a compulsory activity but it is another way of practicing and consolidating reading skills.

This will be a new experience for our Kindergarten children. We found last year that Kindergarten were very enthusiastic and had their readers ready for Early Bird Reading.

The Early Bird Reading Days will be **Tuesdays** and **Wednesdays**. It takes place in our **Multi Purpose Area**.

We begin **at 8:30am** and must **finish by 8:45am** so that teachers who are helping with this extra supervision are able to get back to their classes when the bell goes. It is very disappointing to have to turn children away but unfortunately this does happen when children arrive after 8:45am.

Parents, this is a commitment on your part as well. You will need to have your child at school in enough time to complete the reading of a book or a chapter of the book.

As well as improving reading skills the children will be making friends with students from other grades and they will hopefully see that we are a learning community, here to help one another.
