From the Assistant Principal

The holidays are only a short time away. It's a time for play and relaxation. Everyone is looking forward to the break but there is some evidence to suggest that children experience a negative learning slide because of the time away from the classroom.

Although opinions are divided about whether the 'summer slide' is real many educators stress the importance of reading over the break. Reading to and encouraging your child to read is beneficial. Discussing what has been read to gauge understanding and general responses to the book is a great strategy for parents to use. 'Research by Tom Nicholson, professor of literacy education at Massey University in Auckland, has shown that some students' reading can drop a massive six months over the summer break.' (The Age, December 15, 2014)

Books are a great Christmas gift idea. There are also plenty of e-books that could be purchased as well. Libraries are a good destination for an outing. There are usually planned activities at your local library, so perhaps take the time to investigate what's on offer there.

The summer break often gives us the chance to slow down a little and catch up with friends and relatives that we may not have seen for a while because of the busyness of the year. We also have the time to really talk to our children instead of quick car conversations before they get dropped off to their next activity. Conversation gives us great insight into how our children think and help to deepen our relationship. These conversations can also focus on their learning. Asking about what they have read, explaining something they have seen, retelling the events of the day give us important insights into how our children are growing and developing.

During the course of the day we can use moments to tap into Maths thinking. Simple things, such as asking the time, how much longer until dinner, how long does the movie last, all develop concepts of time. Weighing the apples at the green grocer, noting the difference between grams and kilograms are effective ways that we can develop an understanding of these concepts.

The most important thing is to share this time with your children, to celebrate the birth of our Lord, Jesus Christ as a family and to pray for those in our world who are not as lucky as us. We are blessed in so many ways; let's give thanks for these blessings.

I give thanks for the community of Holy Spirit and I pray that you have a happy and joy filled Christmas and return safely in 2016.






