

Holy Spirit Primary School, St Clair Information and Communications Technology Acceptable Use Agreement

Introduction

The purpose of Information and Communications Technology (ICT) at *Holy Spirit Primary School* is to:

- > enhance student learning opportunities
- > promote student achievement
- > support student school communication

The use of all ICT used at Holy Spirit Primary School should be responsible, legal, appropriate and for educational purpose and should follow the guidelines outlined in this policy.

Definition

'ICT' means Information and Communications Technology. It covers any device or related applications which allow users to record, send, access or receive information, in text, audio, image or video form. These may include but are not limited to:

- computer systems, laptops, iPads, iPods, printers, portable data storage devices
- telephones, mobile phones, smart boards, radio, television
- internet and network services, email, online data storage mediums
- video and still cameras and audio recording devices
- all other digital communications devices owned by CEDP or Holy Spirit Primary School
- social media applications examples include but are not limited to Facebook, YouTube, Twitter, podcast, instant messaging systems, blogs and comments

1. Policy for Students

At *Holy Spirit Primary School*, I have access to Information and Communications Technology to enhance my learning. I must *'BE CYBERWISE'*; that means *'Be Safe'*, *'Be Respectful' and 'Be Responsible'* when using ICT at all times as outlined in *'CYBERWISE'*, published by the Catholic Education Diocese of Parramatta.

2. Acceptable Uses of Information and Communications Technology (ICT)

3. UNACCEPTABLE Uses of Information and Communications Technology (ICT)

Misuse or wilfully damage any device including removal of any piece or part	*	Bring technology from home to use at school without teacher permission (mobile phones may be stored in the Office)	*
Change/delete settings on any computer, device or application	*	Search for inappropriate internet content including images or games	*
Change, copy or delete any work that is not my own	*	Share or record voice/video, images or information of other people without their/teacher permission	*
Access Social Media e.g. Facebook, Twitter YouTube etc unless guided by my teacher	*	Copy other people's work including internet images and claim them as my own	*
Enter into any 'chat' option or facility in any game or application	*	Send or post inappropriate or disrespectful images or comments about others	*
Play games with inappropriate content	*	Install or delete programs or Apps on any device	*
Use inappropriate language in the context of computer applications	*	Download from or upload content to the internet without teacher permission	*



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I can 'BE SAFE' by:

- keeping personal information and passwords private and secure
- only accessing teacher approved internet sources/sites

I can 'BE RESPECTFUL' by:

- observing copyright by acknowledging the authorship of others
- commenting in an appropriate manner when referring to others while using ICT

I can 'BE RESPONSIBLE' by:

- only using ICT provided by the school or approved by a teacher
- caring for ICT in a safe and appropriate manner

4. Consequences if rules are broken

Depending on the rule broken, the following people would be informed:

i) Teacher, ii) Principal, iii) Parents

Wilfully disregarding the rules will result in:

- Timeout to reflect on the consequences of actions taken
- Access to ICT including computers and internet will be withdrawn for a period of time determined by the teacher/principal

Please take note:

Activities that threaten the safety of others or deliberately damage school ICT resources are illegal. Such activities may be reported to the police.

5. Privacy

While the Catholic Education Diocese of Parramatta respects your right to privacy, your use of ICT on CEDP networks and devices is subject to supervision and monitoring to ensure responsible use.
